## **Eligibility for Free Care**

If one or both parents were born in New Zealand, your child can have free check-ups and treatment while they are under 18 years. Some other children can also access free care. Please contact the clinic for more information.

If your family/whanau or child/tamaiti has moved locally or from elsewhere in New Zealand, please ring 0800 825 583 so we can update your details and offer appointments.

### **How Care Is Provided**

Once enrolled the clinic will contact you when your child is due for an appointment. Parents must accompany their children to these appointments to provide consent for treatment if required. If your child is in pain or you have concerns and questions between appointments, please feel welcome to contact the clinic.

At the end of Year 8 children transfer to free Adolescent Oral Health care with a private provider (care is free until age 18). The clinic will arrange this with you.
